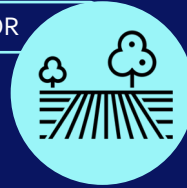

## CHALLENGE

- Wanted to improve resilience, nutrition, incomes, health and food security across all stakeholders in the food supply chain of Ghana's Sawla-Tuna-Kalba District
- Needed to prioritise issues, coordinate stakeholders, develop governance processes and implement key actions

## ACTIONS

- Galvanised stakeholders that were somehow related to food security, including Ministries of Agriculture, Health, Education, local chiefs, market sellers, farmers, hauliers and firefighters
- Developed governance for a District Food Security Network
- Hosted inaugural meetings to identify and prioritise issues and had stakeholders agree to take specific, collaborative actions
- Prepared implementation measures and monitoring and evaluation metrics to track progress and effectiveness

## RESULT

- The District Food Security Network was established and stakeholders recognised their role in its mission
- The Network agreed to jointly support the highest-priority actions in their messaging and outreach activities to rural communities to build a critical mass that would affect change
